#### H & I SUB-COMMITTEE REPORT

#### **JANUARY 2025**

Good morning this month we welcomed five new members We experienced two issues this month with two different facilities. These issues have just been brought to our attention and we have not had a opportunity to address on the sub- committee level. One issue will be able to be dealt with on the sub- committee level while that other will be presented to the area. These will be included in my report next month as we need to have the opportunity to discuss first in H & I, the vice-chair and myself have taken action until then.

There seems to be so misunderstanding concerning the relationship between PR and H&I. for this reason PR and H&I met this month to make sure that we are both working together on any and all projects. We developed a plan of action that the chair's and vice chair's will meet once a month to tackle any issues and to continue the long standing relationship of both committees.

This leads me to an issue that we the sub-committee want to bring to the attention of the area for clarification on a proper plan of action. We the committee have determined this to be of concern, not just for H & I but NA as a whole.

It read as follows:	

Since our last meeting there have been several things that have occurred

There has been contact made between a former member of this committee with a current facility that we currently serve.

Please note that during the course of this report I will protect to the best of my ability anonymity and give only the facts, as I am aware, to the best of my ability.

On December 11 the vice-chair received a text from the individual pertaining to a "covenant" with this facility. The vice-chair then forwarded the text to me and we initiated a conference call with the individual in question. During the course of this call it was conveyed that there should be no further communication between the individual in question and that any communication should be routed through the service structure to be handled by the vice-chair or myself. There was implied understanding of this directive

On December 26th a conversation occurred between the vice-chair and the Clinical Director of the same facility with the same individual in question making contact with the facility again but this time concerning "MAT's" as it pertains to facility and H & I. I then placed a call to the clinical director to obtain additional clarification. I was informed that the facility supports us bringing in a meeting there, but this was passed down to the clinical director who informed his bosses and peers that he would attend H & I and address the issues.

This being a second incident with the same individual making again an unauthorized and unsolicited contact that had what, I believe, the potential to have a negative affect not only H & I but NA as a whole if our credibility was called into question.

I asked the clinical director not to attend, but rather I contacted the area chair to possibly set a meeting with area char and vice-chair, PR chair and vice-chair, H & I chair and vice-chair and the clinical director of the facility. The reason for this request was for this information to be given directly from the source and therefore eliminate things being lost in translation. It was my hopes that we could arrive at a solution on how to move forward in manner that would preserve the anonymity of the individual in question and also to come to a solution of a proper way forward.

After discussion with the chair of the area she informed me that she had taken the following actions.

- a. Spoke with the clinical director of the facility.
- b. Spoken the individual in question (which in my opinion limited an open dialogue)

it was her decision not to proceed therefore prompting this report to the committee. It was my hope that I would be able to have for this body a plan of action to report.

These are the facts as things have unfolded. I present this information to this body with the following options for your consideration.

- a. Do nothing
- b. Continue to pursue this by bringing it up on the area floor
- c. Treat as an H & I issue and not involve area at all




